- Update from Enforcement Officer – Clerk confirmed that he had contacted the Enforcement Officer who confirmed that the case had been assessed and had deemed that due to the residence only having one vehicle on the premises there was no case to answer.
- Update from Environment Agency – Clerk updated that he had spoken to the environment Agency regarding the ditch on Duck Lane. The Agency confirmed they would open a case to resolve the issue.
- Budget – Budget was assessed by Councillors and was resolved to be adopted. It was also resolved to continue with the Devolved services agreement with Bucks County Council
- RoSPA Report – Clerk to share the report with the Play Area Report. It was also suggested that the Play Area committee resolve to find out the cost to the repairs to the medium risk items and provide the cost to the Parish Council to decide if they should resolve on paying the cost of the repairs. It was agreed that the PC would contribute up to £10,000 towards the cost of repairs upon receipt of the report and evidence from the Play Area committee of the areas most in need of repair.
- Ditch in Duck Lane – Play Area Committee confirmed that there were a number of upcoming events over the next few months and would provide updates on the progress of these.
